16.2 Description

The guided-type fall arrester of type Granvia4 including rigid anchor line of type SafeLadder Pro is used to protect one person against the fall from a height.

The user can secure himself at the connector of guided-type fall arrester using the intended arresting eyelet of the arresting belt. The guided-type fall arrester is equipped with a textile energy absorber. The maximum permitted nominal load is 150 kg; the minimum nominal load is 60 kg. The minimum permitted temperature of use is -30 °C. How to place of the guided-type fall arrester on the rigid anchor line in the right direction is indicated by a symbol and ensured by the shape of fall arrester. The rigid anchor lines provided are the rungs of one side of the ladder. The top and bottom ends of the anchor line are each equipped with end stops and fastened by means of brackets.
